1 Corinthians 3:11 and Psalm 11:3

Introduction

Structural engineers assign different reasons for the collapse of buildings especially super-structures. A common defect which is a possible cause is the foundation of the building. Foundation is defined as the support of a building below the ground and is therefore unseen. It is the basis upon which something is founded as a theory or idea. A foundation is very important to the structure of a building and its longevity. Foundations do not come up accidentally. Every foundation must be intentionally laid, whether it is for career, leadership, marriage, facing life's challenges etc.

The apostle Paul says in I Corinthians 3:11-13 "For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.... his work will be shown for what it is because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work"

The Ghana Navigators turn 48 years this year! We have a unique opportunity to grow our faith in God and follow His leading as we implement our 5-Year strategy. The focus of the National Leadership Team is heavy on training at all levels of the ministry & developing a Missional Community of believers. A Missional Community are believers who are burdened with the Great Commission (Mark 16:15). We are trusting God for a Missional community of believers committed to the urgent need of the gospel to the un-reached and under-reached people groups in urban and rural Ghana.

30th Annual General Meeting (AGM)

The Annual General Meeting is the highest decision-making body in the Ghana Navigators. It is at the annual meeting that major decisions are finalized, and leadership gives account of their stewardship to the Navigator family for the period.

The unreached people are a people group among which there is no indigenous community of believing Christians with adequate number of resources to evangelize this people group without external assistance. They can be reached through their mother tongue if literacy programmes/materials and Bible are produced to help them understand the salvation message

Week 1: **Chakali**

The population of the Chakali is 9,000 and 3% of the population are Christians. The Chakali people are located in Wa East and their chief town is Bulenga. Some of the Chakali people groups have also relocated to live among the Wala people group and adopted their language. Most of the traditions and beliefs of the Chakali are geared towards ancestral worship. They are very superstitious and attribute a lot of happenings to the supernatural.

Formerly, when you did not know God, you were slaves to those who by nature are not gods. But now that you know God — or rather are known by God — how is it that you are turning back to those weak and miserable principles? Do you wish to be enslaved by them all over again? Galatians 4:8-9 (NIV)

- Pray against syncretism among believers. This is important because most converts still hold on to certain traditional beliefs and they need a renewal of mind.
- 2 Pray that God will lead Christian teachers and workers to serve among the people.
- Ask God to give the Chakali Christians opportunities to share the Gospel with their own people.
- 4 Pray that the Lord will grant wisdom and favour to the mission agencies and churches that are working among the Chakali.
- Ask the Holy spirit to soften the hearts of the Chakali people so that they will be receptive to the gospel.
- Pray that churches especially in Wa will begin to move toward the Chakali communities in the Wa East District.

Week 2: Challa

The Challa people group are predominantly found in Northern Volta in Nkwanta (south and north) with a few in the Northern Region. There is an unaccounted number of Challas scattered throughout the country. The Challa people are traditionally animist with a strong fetish culture. Recently, many Challa people are converting to Islam and some few to Christianity. The main deity of the Challa is called Challa Jogo. They believe he gives them health, protection, fertility and anything spiritual or material. There are tribal tensions among the Challa and the Akyode people groups on land ownership and people are very sensitive to tribal issues.

Many of those who believed now came and openly confessed their evil deeds. A number who had practiced sorcery brought their scrolls together and burned them publicly............ In this way the word of the Lord spread widely and grew in power. Acts 19:18-20 (NIV)

- Pray against syncretism and nominalism as the few Christians who go to church are also involved in traditional rituals and sacrifices.
- 2 Pray for support for their language translation, as it is almost going extinct.
- **3** Pray for the planting of indigenous churches among them.
- Pray against the varied ethnic conflicts between the Challa and the
 Akyode people groups and also among the different factions in Challa land.

Week 3: **Dyula**

The Christianity percentage among the Dyula is 1% as against a population of 68, 045. The Djulaare are located mostly in the bigger cities and coastal areas of Ghana. The majority of Dyula are Sunni Muslims. Most of the others, whom the Muslims call "pagans," hold traditional animistic beliefs (they believe that non-living objects have spirits). There are no known active churches.

Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few; therefore, pray the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into His harvest. Luke 10:2-3 (NKJV)

- Ask the Lord of the harvest to send forth labourers to live and work among the Dyula.
- 2 Ask God to anoints the Gospel as it goes forth via radio and television to the Dyula.
- Pray for the effective use of the Jesus Film and other evangelistic materials in the Dyula language.
- 4 Ask God to strengthen, encourage, and protect the small number of Dyula Christians.
- **5** Ask the Lord to bring forth a triumphant Dyula church for the glory of His name.

Week 4: Foodo

The Foodo are virtually all Sunni Muslim. The population of the Foodo is 1,100 with less than 1% being Christians. The Foodo are located in Aflao, Accra, Ho and Tema. A few traditional animistic practices (based on the belief that non-living things have spirits) still practice still persist among some. Such practices are done in secret, since animists are looked down upon by the Foodo. There are no currently known active churches in the towns.

- Ask the Lord of the harvest to send forth labourers to live and work among the Foodo people.
- 2 Pray for the effective use of the Jesus Film and other evangelistic materials in the Foodo language.
- Ask God to strengthen, encourage and protect the small number of Foodo Christians.
- 4 Ask the Lord to bring forth a triumphant Foodo church in Ghana.
- **5** Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among the Foodo.
- Pray that Christians medical terms and teachers will have opportunities to minister Life to the Foodo.

Week 1: Gonja

The population of the Gonja group of people is 309,527 but has about 4% as Christians. Most Gonja can be found in West Gonja, Central and East Gonja. There are chieftaincy disputes in some parts of the Gonjaland including Bole and Damango. The Gonjas tend to practice Islam alongside their ethnic religious practices. If a member of a Gonja tribe becomes a Christian, they believe the person has lost his identity and must be an outcast.

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong. 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 (NIV)

- Ask God to strengthen, encourage and protect the small number of Gonja who converted to Christianity.
- 2 Pray for the few followers of Christ to be disciples and trained into mature believers and leaders.
- Pray for churches in the big towns such as Damango, Bole, Salaga, Bupei to engage the Gonjas continually and faithfully.
- 4 Pray for the indigenous leaders and lay pastors to be well equipped for the work within their catchment areas and beyond.
- **5** Pray for Muslim leaders, family and clan heads to encounter the gospel.
- Pray for the use of literacy materials and stories to engage the Gonja people in their heart language.
- 7 Pray for calm as the people in Bole settle chieftaincy disputes and enskin a new Paramount chief.

Week 2: Hausa

The population of the Hausa is 209,786 but the percentage of Christianity is 0%. The Hausa people can be found throughout Ghana, with a large number of them living in the Zongo. Majority of Hausa people in Ghana are Muslims. However, the religious practices of the Hausa have been mixed with local traditions. They are known to hold down several occupations at the same time such as positions in the military, trade and commerce and the spreading of Islam.

The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ. - 2 Corinthians 10:4-5 (NIV)

- Pray for the Lord Jesus to miraculously demolish the stronghold of Islam among this people group.
- 2 Ask the Lord to send long term labourers to live among the Hausa people and share the love of Christ with them.
- Pray that God will raise faithful intercessors who will stand in the gap for the Hausa people.
- Ask God to strengthen, encourage, and protect the small number of Muslim Hausa who have converted to Christianity.
- Pray that their traditional Muslim culture will soften, creating open doors for the gospel to be preached among them.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to open the hearts of the Hausa people towards Christians so that they will be receptive to the gospel.
- **7** Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage the Hausa people.
- 8 Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among the Hausa people.

Week 3: Kamara

The Kamara are located in Western Gonja land in the Northern Region of Ghana. Larabanga and Dakrupe are the two main Kamara towns in Ghana. Engaging the Kamara visibly might lead to persecution and attacks, especially in Dakrupe. The Kamara people are predominantly Muslims and everyone aspires to be a Mallam. Larabanga is one of the few documented hundred percent Muslim communities in Ghana. Their community is the regional pivot of Muslim spirituality in the northern part of Ghana.

Therefore, they stayed there a long time, speaking boldly in the Lord, who was bearing witness to the word of His grace, granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands. - Acts 14:3 (NKJV)

- 1 Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage the Kamara.
- Pray that the Lord raise faithful intercessors who will stand in the gap for the Kamara
- Ask God to strengthen, encourage and protect the small number of Kamara who converted to Christianity.
- Pray that their traditional Muslim culture will soften, creating open doors for the gospel to be preached among them.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to open the hearts of the Kamara Christians So that they will be receptive to the gospel.
- 6 Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among them.
- **7** Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers to them.
- **8** Pray that Christian professionals will accept postings among the Kamaras so as to reach them.

Week 4: **Kantonsi**

The Kantosi people are scattered all over Ghana. They live in different locations and adopt the language of the people they live with. Majority of the Kantosi people are Muslims. All of them may not practice Islam, but all must identify themselves as Muslims. The Kantosis are not allowed to become Christians. They have been engaged by churches and mission agencies but the Kantosi Christians do not boldly declare their faith. They do not have the evangelistic materials available in their language.

...The Lord opened her heart to respond to Paul's message... - Acts 16:14b(NIV)

- 1 Pray for the Holy Spirit to open the hearts of the Kantosis to the gospel.
- 2 Pray for the Holy Spirit to give dreams and visions to members of the Kantosi people that will open their hearts to Christ.
- **3** Pray for a rapid church planting movement among them.
- 4 Pray for the Ghanaian church to take keen interest in the Kantosi people.
- **5** Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage the Kantosi.
- 6 Ask the Lord to raise very strong local churches among the Kantosi.
- 7 Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers to them, especially Christian NGOs.

Focus for June

The unreached people are a people group among which there is no indigenous community of believing Christians with adequate number of resources to evangelize this people group without external assistance. They can be reached through their mother tongue if literacy programmes/materials and Bible are produced to help them understand the salvation message

Week 1: **Kotokoli**

The Kotokoli people are predominantly found in the Northern Volta in Nkwanta. The Kotokoli people are from Kue in Ghana, Togo or Benin. In Ghana, the Kotokolis are primarily Muslims. Since the Kotokolis are strongly committed to Islam, very few have anything to do with traditional religion. There are churches in their towns and villages but converts come for prayers privately or they do not come at all.

.... but I gave them this command: Obey me, and I will be your God and you will be my people. Walk in all the ways I command you, that it may go well with you. - Jeremiah 7:23(NIV)

- There are many Kotokoli people who come for prayers. Pray for true conversions and boldness to declare to their faith.
- **2** Pray for the establishment of indigenous churches among the Kotokoli people.
- Pray for the Churches to move into the Kotokoli Communities and reach out to them.
- 4 Pray for Kotokoli chiefs and Muslim leaders to respond to the gospel.
- **5** Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage them.
- 6 Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among them.
- 7 Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers to them, especially church workers and professional Christians.

Week 2: Mamprusi

The population of the Mamprusi is 315,992 and the Christianity percentage is less than 1%. They located in the in the North East Region of Ghana. The Mamprusi tend to value traditional ethnic beliefs and customs. The society is patrilineal and therefore any man who accepts Christ loses their political and familial power.

Then he said to them all: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it. - Luke 9:23-24

- Pray against syncretism and nominalism. The few Christians who go to church are also involved in traditional rituals and sacrifices. The unfortunate thing is that they see nothing wrong with that.
- There is a dire need for indigenous leaders among the Mamprusi people group to lead their own people in their mother tongue.
- There are several chieftaincy and royal issues. Pray for all pockets of tension and potential conflicts that may emerge.
- Families and individuals have submitted to traditional worship, rituals and sacrifices. Pray that individuals are set free from every form of bondage.
- Islam is moving fast into Mamprusi settlements. We must pray for some more strategies and labourers.
- 6 Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage the Mamprusi.
- **7** Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers.
- Pray that Christian professionals will accept postings among the Mamprusi so as to reach them.

Week 3: Mandinka

The Mandinka are scattered all over the country Ghana. They are mostly found in Tema, Ashaiman, Buipe and Accra. The Mandinka are largely Sunni Muslims. Christianity is 2% in respect to population.

I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws - Ezekiel 36:26-27(NIV)

- Pray for God to renew the hearts of the Mandinka people and draw them close to Himself.
- There are several chieftaincy and royal issues. Pray for all pockets of tension and potential conflicts that may emerge to be settled.
- Islam is moving fast into their settlements. We must pray for more strategies to reach them.
- 4 Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage the Mandinka people.
- **5** Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers and professionals to work among them.
- There is a dire need for indigenous leaders among the Mandinka people group to lead their own people in their mother tongue.

Week 4: Nanumba

The percentage of Christians is below 1% of their population. The Nanumba people have been unengaged with no evangelical presence. Most of them practice ethnic religion. For generations, the Nanumba practiced idol worship. Their traditional religion teaches that the 'high creator' is unapproachable. They are located in the North and South districts in the Northern region (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

...I am sending you to them. To open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me. - Acts 26:17b-18 (NIV)

- Pray that God will use the Nanumba believers to share the love of Jesus with their own people.
- 2 Ask the Holy Spirit to grant wisdom and favour to any mission agencies labouring among the Nanumba.
- Ask the Lord to raise additional labourers in Ghana to work among these people.
- 4 Pray that God will open the hearts of the Nanumba leaders to receive the Gospel.
- Ask God to raise prayer teams that will begin breaking up the land through worship and intercession.
- 6 Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among the Nanumba.
- 7 Pray against all forms of idols and war shines stationed among them, especially among the Bimbila people.
- Pray for unity and understanding among the different gates in the land so that a new paramount chief can be peacefully enskinned.


