Introduction

Structural engineers assign different reasons for the collapse of buildings especially super-structures. A common defect which is a possible cause is the foundation of the building. Foundation is defined as the support of a building below the ground and is therefore unseen. It is the basis upon which something is founded as a theory or idea. A foundation is very important to the structure of a building and its longevity. Foundations do not come up accidentally. Every foundation must be intentionally laid, whether it is for career, leadership, marriage, facing life's challenges etc.

Kumasi Ministry



The Kumasi Ministry actively engages students of the Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology (KNUST), High schools, recent graduates and couples and have discipleship with them. The Navigators has an active presence on the KNUST campus, and some high schools in Kumasi. The Kumasi Ministry is led by Selassie Tettetdje

Prayer Points

- 1** Pray for obedient labourers to be multiplied in the existing and new ministry areas in Kumasi (I Timothy 1:5)
- 2** For full funding for the Kumasi Navigator Work (Luke 8:1-3)
- 3** For God to raise and help us identify at least one person in the various levels of training who would serve as a key pillar for the Navigator work in Kumasi over the next 3 to 5 years (II Timothy 2:2)
- 4** To have access to the Senior High Schools in Kumasi to share the gospel with students and disciple them. Most of the Senior High Schools were not open to receiving visitors last academic year because of Covid restrictions.
- 5** For God's guidance concerning where to embark on missions' outreach in 2022 and for God to give us the opportunity to partner with others who also carry a burden for reaching the lost (Psalm 32:8)
- 6** That many who are lost will be saved as Navigator Labourers in Kumasi engage them (Acts 4:12)
- 7** For God to work in the hearts of Foster and Carta as they learn and serve in Kumasi over the next four months (Jeremiah 17:10)

Unreached People

Week 1: Kantonsi

The Kantosi people are scattered all over Ghana. They live in different locations and adopt the language of the people they live with. Majority of the Kantosi people are Muslims. All of them may not practice Islam, but all identify themselves as Muslims. The Kantosis are not allowed to become Christians. They have been engaged by churches and mission agencies but the Kantosi Christians do not boldly declare their faith. They do not have the evangelistic materials available in their language (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

Prayer Points

-
- 1** Pray for the Holy Spirit to open the hearts of the Kantosis to the gospel.

 - 2** Pray for the Holy Spirit to reveal Christ to the Kantosis through dreams and visions.

 - 3** Pray for a rapid church planting movement among them.

 - 4** Pray for the Ghanaian church to take keen interest in the Kantosi people.

 - 5** Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage the Kantosis.

 - 6** Ask the Lord to raise very strong local churches among the Kantosis.

 - 7** Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers to them, especially Christian NGOs.

Week 2: Kotokoli

The Kotokoli people are predominantly found in the Northern Volta in Nkwanta. The Kotokoli people are from Kue in Ghana, Togo or Benin. In Ghana, the Kotokolis are primarily Muslims. Since the Kotokolis are strongly committed to Islam, very few have anything to do with traditional religion. There are churches in their towns and villages but converts come for prayers privately or they do not come at all (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

... but I gave them this command: Obey me, and I will be your God and you will be my people. Walk in all the ways I command you, that it may go well with you. Jeremiah 7:23 (NIV).

Prayer Points

- 1 There are many Kotokoli people who come for prayers. Pray for true conversions and boldness to declare to their faith.
- 2 Pray for the establishment of indigenous churches among the Kotokoli people.
- 3 Pray for the Churches to move into the Kotokoli Communities and reach out to them.
- 4 Pray for Kotokoli chiefs and Muslim leaders to respond to the gospel.
- 5 Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage them.
- 6 Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among them.
- 7 Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers to them, especially church workers and professional Christians.

Unreached People

Week 3: Mamprusi

The population of the Mamprusi is 315,992 and the percentage of Christians is less than 1%. They are located in the North East Region of Ghana. The Mamprusi tend to value traditional ethnic beliefs and customs. The society is patrilineal and therefore any man who accepts Christ loses their political and familial power. They need great attention from church leaders and missionaries (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

Then he said to them all: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it. Luke 9:23-24

Prayer Points

-
- 1 Pray against syncretism and nominalism. The few Christians who go to church are also involved in traditional rituals and sacrifices. The unfortunate thing is that they see nothing wrong with that.

 - 2 There is a dire need for indigenous leaders among the Mamprusi people group to lead their own people in their mother tongue.

 - 3 There are several chieftaincy and royal issues. Pray for all pockets of tension and potential conflicts that may emerge.

 - 4 Families and individuals have submitted to traditional worship, rituals and sacrifices. Pray that individuals are set free from every form of bondage.

 - 5 Islam is moving fast into Mamprusi settlements. Pray for some more strategies and labourers.

 - 6 Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage the Mamprusi.

 - 7 Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers.

 - 8 Pray that Christian professionals will accept postings among the Mamprusi so as to reach them.

Week 4: Mandinka

The Mandinka are scattered all over the country Ghana. They are mostly found in Tema, Ashaiman, Buipe, and Accra. The Mandinka are largely Sunni Muslims. Christianity is 2% in respect to population. The New Testament has been translated, and the Jesus film is also accessible. In Ghana, there are few mission agencies that work with the Mandinka people. In spite of these there are still few known believers (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws Ezekiel 36:26-27(NIV)

Prayer Points

-
- 1** Pray for God to renew the hearts of the Mandinka people and draw them close to Himself.

 - 2** There are several chieftaincy and royal issues. Pray for all pockets of tension and potential conflicts that may emerge to be settled.

 - 3** Islam is moving fast into their settlements. We must pray for more strategies to reach them.

 - 4** Pray for boldness on the part of believers to engage the Mandinka people.

 - 5** Pray that the Lord will send long term labourers and professionals to work among them.

 - 6** There is a dire need for indigenous leaders among the Mandinka people group to lead their own people in their mother tongue.

Prayer Points

Church Discipleship Ministry



Upon invitation the Navigators partner with churches to train and disciple key leaders and available persons in the church who also disciple others within the church. The Church Discipleship Ministry is currently led by Emmanuel Ebo Baidoo.

Prayer Points

-
- 1** Pray that Navigators active in local churches will be strategic to not only disciple someone but be instrumental to influence leadership to embrace discipleship (II Timothy 2:15)

 - 2** Pray for Increased partnership with church leaders. To identify church leaders who are hungry for training and coaching in Disciple-making. Pray for committed pastors who are willing to see this happen in their churches (Acts 6:3)

 - 3** Pray for Navigators to be encouraged to not only find their place (ministry) in the Church but to identify faithful ones and help them grow to be disciples who can make disciples (II Timothy 3:16-17)

 - 4** Pray that disciple making will take root in the church. For many to seek a deep yearning for the only true God. (John 15:16 and Acts 17:27)

Marketplace (Workplace) & Community Ministry



This ministry area is one of the new initiatives to ensure the gospel is intentionally being taken to our workplaces, communities, neighbourhood etc. Essentially the gospel must go wherever a Navigator lives or works. This ministry is led by Ken Dawson.

Prayer Points

-
- 1** Pray for committed members who will grow to become labourers (I Timothy 1:5).

 - 2** Pray for Navigator Members who own businesses: We are grateful God has blessed some Navigators such that they could own businesses and employ others. Pray God's blessing on the businesses. Pray God will bless them with faithful employees. Pray for God's favour and wisdom especially in the current business environment (Deuteronomy 8:18, Luke 16:10, I Chronicles 12:32).

 - 3** Pray that all Navigators will become aware of the vast opportunity for reaching their colleagues with the Gospel of Jesus (Romans 10:13-15).

 - 4** Pray for members in the marketplace to excel in their careers (Isaiah 48:17).

 - 5** Pray for revival of community ministry (Psalm 85:6).

Unreached People

Week 1: Nanumba

The percentage of Christians is below 1% of their population. The Nanumba people have been unengaged with no evangelical presence. Most of them practice ethnic religion. For generations, the Nanumba practiced idol worship. Their traditional religion teaches that the 'high creator' is unapproachable. They are located in the North and South districts in the Northern region (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

...I am sending you to them. To open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me. Acts 26:17b-18 (NIV)

Prayer Points

-
- 1** Pray that God will use the Nanumba believers to share the love of Jesus with their own people.

 - 2** Ask the Holy Spirit to grant wisdom and favour to any mission agencies labouring among the Nanumba.

 - 3** Ask the Lord to raise additional labourers in Ghana to work among these people.

 - 4** Pray that God will open the hearts of the Nanumba leaders to receive the Gospel.

 - 5** Ask God to raise prayer teams that will begin breaking up the land through worship and intercession.

 - 6** Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among the Nanumba.

 - 7** Pray against all forms of idols and war shins stationed among them, especially among the Bimbila people.

 - 8** Pray for unity and understanding among the different gates in the land so that a new paramount chief can be peacefully enskinned.

Unreached People

Week 2: Songhay-Koryaboro

The Songhay are Sunni Muslims. Even though Islam introduced new element to the Songhai culture, it left the underlying framework of the custom and tradition virtually untouched. Islam is important to the people as evidenced in the fact every town has a mosque or at least a Friday Mosque. Though the Songhay people have been engaged with the gospel, about 98% of population are still unbelievers (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

This is good, and pleases God our Saviour, who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. 1 Timothy 2:3-4 (NIV)

Prayer Points

-
- 1** Pray for the Songhay-Koryaboro people to come to the knowledge of the truth.

 - 2** Ask the Holy Spirit to grant wisdom and favour to mission agencies and Churches to identify and engage this people.

 - 3** Pray that God will open the hearts of the Songhay people to receive the Gospel.

 - 4** Ask God to raise prayer teams that will begin breaking up the land through worship and intercession.

 - 5** Pray against all forms of idols and also that the stronghold of Islam would be broken.

Unreached People

Week 3: Wala

The town of Wa and parts of the Wa urban are where the Wala people can be found. Most of the Wala have partially adopted Islam. Islam is often mixed with magical practices as people seek good fortune and protection from harm and evil powers. Witchcraft and sorcery also persist. About 0.29% of a population of 84,810 are Christians (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

The Lord your God will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your descendants, so that you may love him with all your heart and with all your soul, and live. Deuteronomy 30:6 (NIV)

Prayer Points

-
- 1** Pray for God to circumcise the hearts of the Wala people.

 - 2** Ask the Holy Spirit to grant wisdom and favour to mission agencies focusing on the Wala.

 - 3** Ask God to raise additional long-term missionaries to join the few who have already responded.

 - 4** Pray that signs and wonders will follow the Wala believers as they share Christ with their own people.

 - 5** Ask God to raise prayer teams that will begin breaking up the spiritual soil of West Africa through intercession.

 - 6** Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among the Wala.

 - 7** Pray for resources for the churches in the Wala communities.

 - 8** Pray for effective ways they can be reached with the gospel.

Unreached People

Week 4: Zerma

The Zerma are predominantly Sunni Muslims. They also practice traditional religion which involves wearing charms and amulets and consulting mediums. Apart from Ghana, they are located in Niger, Nigeria, Burkina Faso, Mali and Benin. Churches and mission agencies have engaged the Zarma people but only 0.05% of the 8,500 Zerma people are Christians (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

“No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day”. John 6:44 (NIV)

Prayer Points

-
- 1 Pray that the Zerma people will become broken hearted over their sins and will seek their Saviour.

 - 2 Pray that the Almighty God will break down walls and strongholds that have dominated these dear people for centuries.

 - 3 Pray for a Christ- oriented disciple -making movement to flourish among the Zerma people in Ghana.

 - 4 Pray for Christian workers and professionals among them.

 - 5 Pray for churches to adopt this people group.

 - 6 Pray for new ministry approaches and strategies towards the Zerma people.

Focus for March

Praying Through the Nav Calling

Our Calling:

To advance the Gospel of Jesus and His kingdom into the nations through spiritual generations of laborers living and discipling among the lost.

Prayer Points

Advancing the Gospel of Jesus and His kingdom.

 - 2** Pray that the Lord will give us clear convictions on ministry areas to concentrate on (Acts 6:2)

 - 3** Pray that the Lord will strengthen each Labourer to grow personally in our walk with Him (II Timothy 2:15)

 - 4** Pray that the Lord will cause growth and development in each ministry area (Colossians 1:10)

Transition Ministry/Navs Under 30



The Transition Ministry focuses on graduates under the age of 30. The Ministry provides the graduates with guidance and mentoring as they make major life decisions. The Transition ministry ensures each member continues to receive intentional discipleship and are organized to disciple others. The Transition Ministry is led by Kwabena Owusu.

Prayer Points

-
- 1 Kindly pray with us for God's grace and provision to be able to execute the plans we have for the ministry in 2022 (Psalm 19:21)

 - 2 Also join us pray for full participation and availability of the members of the ministry for the different activities we have for 2022 (Ecclesiastes 12:1)

 - 3 Pray for full funding for the year's activities (Philippians 4:19)

 - 4 Pray that God will burden us to seek Him and His will for our lives. That our lives will bring Glory to His name (I Kings 8:58)

 - 5 For job opportunities, opportunities for further education and marriage for members of the ministry who are trusting God for one (Psalm 84:11, 12)

Unreached People

Week 1: Anufo

The Anufo has a population of 91,275, only 0.72% of them are Christians. The Anufo dwell in the North-Eastern part of Ghana. Although they are mainly idol worshippers, Islam is growing speedily among the Anufo people group. There are inter-tribal conflicts and tensions between the Anufo and Konkomba people groups (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

"...Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost."
Luke 19:9-10 (NIV)

Prayer Points

-
- 1 Pray that the new Anufo believers will grow in dedication to Christ and lead lives that are a good testimony to their neighbours.

 - 2 Pray against the influx of Islam and their domination among the Anufo people.

 - 3 Pray that religious leaders, clans and heads of families will respond to the gospel.

 - 4 Pray against syncretism in the churches working among the Anufo people. This is important because some individuals in the church still pay allegiance to diviners and spirits for intervention in their issues.

 - 5 Pray for more laborers to engage the Anufo people.

 - 6 The New Testament, the Jesus Film, and the audio recordings are available in Anufo language: pray that they will be shared widely with others.

 - 7 Pray for peace and tolerance between the Anufo and their neighbours (especially the Kontomba people).

Unreached People

Week 2: Arabs

The Arabs in Ghana are usually located in the big cities and towns. The Arabs represent the largest, most diverse and most politically influential Muslim ethnic group in the world. Fundamentalist Muslims are very outspoken against Christianity and therefore much prayer is needed to break down the barriers that separate them from Jesus. The Arabs in Ghana are usually located in the big cities and towns (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved. Acts 4:12 (NIV)

Prayer Points

-
- 1 Pray for the Arabs to come to the knowledge of the gospel and be transformed by the gospel.

 - 2 Pray for the Lord Jesus to miraculously demolish the stronghold of Islam among this people group.

 - 3 Pray massively missionary efforts through these immigrants to be thwarted.

 - 4 Pray for the Arabs to encounter Jesus Christ through visions, dreams and faithful witnesses.

 - 5 Pray for courage and perseverance to follow Jesus when it means loss of family, future, and even life.

Unreached People

Week 3: Banda-Ligbi

The Banda-Ligbi have been engaged by churches and mission agencies. However, there are only a handful of known Ligbi Christians in Ghana. They are located in the Ahafo region and Northern region. Most of the Ligbi people practice the Islamic religion. Some Banda-Ligbi people are violent to the gospel and there have been cases where workers were threatened and attacked (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

"Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Matthew 28:19-20 (NIV)

Prayer Points

-
- 1 Ask the Lord to call people who are willing to go and share Christ with the Ligbi.

 - 2 Pray that God will lead Christian teachers and workers to serve among the people.

 - 3 Ask God to give the Banda Christians opportunities to share the gospel with their own people.

 - 4 Pray that the Lord will grant wisdom and favour to the mission agencies that are working among the Ligbi people.

 - 5 Ask the Holy Spirit to soften the hearts of the Ligbi towards Christians so that they will be receptive to the Gospel.

 - 6 Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among the Ligbi.

Week 4: Busanga

The homeland of the Busanga people is in Burkina Faso but they are found in some villages in the Upper East Region. The primary religion of the Busangas is Islam. The Busanga people are keen traders. Some migrate and explore other jobs in the south including public services, the police and the army. Those who migrate retain links with relatives in their places of origin (Ghana Evangelism Committee, 2020).

Therefore, Jesus said again, "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep. All who ever came before me were thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved." John 10:7-9 NIV

 - 5 Ask the Holy Spirit to soften the hearts of the Busanga so that they will be receptive to the Gospel.

 - 6 Ask the Lord to call people who are willing to go and share Christ with the Busanga.

 - 7 Ask the Lord to raise strong local churches among them.
